#### What to Expect Sundays If You are Attending in Person (reservations required):

- Pews will be color-coded: 9:00 am yellow; 10:30 am blue
- Please sit distanced from people <u>not</u> in your family unit
- Please return outdoors immediately after the service (no gathering inside, please)

Note: Windows will not be open in the Sanctuary. The reason: We just installed new ionizers in the rooftop units to kill viruses, germs and bacteria. Also, highly efficient air filters (Merv-13) were added to stop particles of viruses, etc. These systems all function more efficiently with predictable air flow, free of outside particles or contaminants. While it may seem counterintuitive, keeping the windows closed is actually safer from a health perspective.

**Sabbatical Announcement—Summer 2021** FCCGE has long recognized the value of sabbaticals to our clergy and our congregation. Sabbaticals allow our clergy to rest, refresh and renew. We believe it best that our clergy take their sabbaticals on a regular basis. As such, our call letters with Pastors Seth and Kendra provide for a three-month sabbatical every five years. This summer marks five years since Seth's last sabbatical.

Following the June 6<sup>th</sup> service and Annual Meeting, Seth will take his sabbatical, be absent from the Church through the summer and return in early September for Rally Day and the start of our new Church year.
